Hazard Statement: Flammable liquid and vapor. Causes eye irritation. Wear protective gloves/eye protection/face protection. Store in a well-ventilated place. Keep cool. Keep away from heat, sparks, open flames and hot surfaces. No smoking. Keep container tightly closed. Ground/Bond container and receiving equipment. Use only non-sparking tools. Take precautionary measures against static discharge.


